



Aka omote is a medium growing A. japonicum to about 16'. Spring color is red with distinctive green veins, soon fading to a medium green. Fall color is orange to burnt red. (Red Surface)





Akegarasu is a larger leafed red A. palmatum, leaves fading to a reddish green in heat of summer. It will be a larger growing Japanese maple perhaps to 20', as wide as tall. Fall color is crimson. (Crows at Dawn)





Aka hosada is a red upright linearlobum Japanese maple. The fall color is a nice garnet red. It is smaller in structure than Atrolineare. It is not a true dwarf probably reaching 10' at maturity.





Akikaze nishiki is a hardy glossy leaved truncatum to about 25' taller than wide. It has white variegation over green. Fall color is orange and red.





Ao hici go san is a green linearlobum palmatum similar to and possibly the same as Shinobuga oka. It is a more upright grower then Linearlobum or Ao shime no uchi. Fall color is a yellow orange.





<u>Ao kanzanshi</u> is a narrow, vase-shaped tree with subtle Butterfly-like variegation. It has an outstanding pink to red fall color. Ao kanzanshi retains its vase shape even as an old tree, reaching 15' to 20' tall at maturity. (Green Hairpin)








Ao shime no uchi shidare is a spreading, but not weeping A. palmatum. Leaves seem to have wider lobes than the more common Ao shime no uchi and is probably smaller growing plant. Fall color is yellow to orange.



Ao shime no uchi is a green linearlobum maple with orange overtones on the mature leaves. It has bright yellow-orange fall color with a heavy red seed set. It layers out to make an outstanding specimen. Mature plants are slightly taller than they are wide to approximately 15'. (Green within New Years Day)





Aocha nishiki forms a broad tree up to 10 feet. Reputed to be variegated in the Orido nishiki group, but variegation never seen. Foliage is an attractive yellow green. Probably the same scion as Aoba nishiki. (Yellow green brocade)






Aoyagi is sometimes referred to as the green counterpart to Sango kaku. The foliage is a bright lime in spring and throughout the summer. It is one of the few palmatum cultivars with a consistent clear yellow fall color. It has bright pea green branches that become yellowish in the winter. Aoyagi's leaves are smaller and more twisted than Ukon's. (Green coral)











<u>Arianna</u> is divided leafed A. japonicum that appears to be columnar in shape. Spring foliage is lime green, with yellow and orange fall color. Mature height and width is unknown.





Atrolineare is red upright with narrow linearlobum leaves, giving it a delicate appearance. The spring color has a pinkish cast, summer color holds a deep red. It has a nice red seed set and crimson fall color. It is a smaller tree, between 12' -15', and is wider than it is tall.









Attaryi is a large growing upright A. japonicum with leaves cut more than half way down the leaf. It is said to approach 40' in height. Fall color is an excellent yellow, orange and red.

Aureum (Palmatum) is a vase shaped A. palmatum with butter yellow spring growth, maturing to a lime green. It should not be confused with A. shirasawanum Aureum. Fall color is a nice mix of yellow, orange and red.





<u>Autumn Moon</u> is a smaller Acer shirasawanum with attractive burnt orange colored leaves. It has wonderful orange to red fall color. It is a better grower than Aureum, forming a round head at about 10' in height. It seems to withstand heat better than most of the other A. shirasawanum cultivars.

<u>Avalanche</u> is a Psuedosieboldianum x palmatum cross bred for cold hardiness. Spring foliage is a bright yellow orange fading to a chartreuse green. Fall color is a blend of yellow, orange and red.



Azuma murasaki has red spring color that fades to a strong green. The new growth is an orange-red, giving the plant a two-toned effect. Azuma murasaki forms a medium-sized tree to about 15'. It is a similar plant to Kinran in color and habit.







<u>Baby Ghost</u> is a broad upright tree with pink spring leaves fading to a medium green. It will form a small tree to about 10 feet, as wide as tall. Fall color is a bright orange red.





Baton Rouge is a new coral bark maple originating near Houston Texas. It is said to be extremely heat tolerant and do well in full sun in the South. Winter bark is a strong red, similar to Sango kaku. Mature height and width are unknown. (Red Stick in French)





<u>Beni gasa</u> is a round headed red palmatum similar to Burgundy Lace in leaf. It will form a small tree to about 10 to 12'. Fall color is garnet orange. (Red umbrella)





Akane hagoromo (Beni hagoromo) is a red form of palmatum with leaves deeply divided to the base, giving the look of five leaflets per leaf. As the leaf matures, the red foliage fades to a medium green. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 15'. Fall color is a nice orange and garnet. (Red clothes of the angels)





<u>Beni kagami</u> is a red upright with deeply divided leaves. Spring growth is a garnet red, maturing to a purple red. This is a medium growing tree, probably to 10 to 12' tall. It will be wider than tall at maturity. Fall color is crimson. (Red mirror)







Beni Kawa is a plant with beautiful red winter bark. It is more roundheaded than Sango kaku's vase shape. The winter bark is more of a true red when compared to the Sango kaku's coral bark. The choice between the two varieties is best judged by the shape desired in the landscape. (Red skin or red river)





Beni musame is a smaller growing green palmatum with pink red spring growth. Fall color is a good yellow and orange.



<u>Beni otake</u> is a red upright with a bamboo-like appearance. It has brilliant red linearlobum leaves in spring, and its color grows brighter as other varieties fade in the heat of summer. Beni Otake is more upright than Atrolineare. Fall color is scarlet. (big red bamboo)





<u>Bi hou</u> is a new yellow bark variety of coral bark maple from Japan. Mature size is unknown, but probably similar to Sango kaku in form and size, It has great economic potential. Bi hou has excellent yellow to orange fall color. (Beautiful mountain range)







<u>Black Lace</u> is a smaller growing upright maple similar to Burgundy Lace. Foliage is black red in spring and bright crimson in the fall with attractive green seed. At maturity, the plant will be about 16', tall as wide.





<u>Bloodgood</u> is the classic red upright, holding a deep red color throughout the summer. It is more upright growing than Emperor I. Bloodgood is the most popular of any Acer palmatum variety.







Bloody Talons is a bushy upright palmatum with leaves curving downward in the form of talons. Spring foliage is a light green with a prominent center vein and wrinkly leaves. Fall color is a beautiful crimson.







Bonnie Bergman is a fast growing green upright with pinkish spring growth fading to soft green. Fall color is a good orange red.







<u>Boskoop Glory</u> is a vigorous red upright palmatum similar in coloration to Oshio beni. It is somewhat more upright than Oshio beni and has excellent scarlet fall color.







Bronze Age is an A. shirasawanum palmatum cross with greenish purple bronze spring growth. It will be a wide spreading tree, probably taller than wide. Fall color is an outstanding yellow and orange.





<u>Burgundy Jewel</u> is a purple form of Acer circinatum. Spring leaves are green, quickly turning purple red as the leaf matures. Ultimate height is unknown but probably under 15'. Fall color is orange red.







<u>Burgundy Lace</u> is a red upright with deeply cut leaves. It holds an excellent red summer color. It makes a nice round specimen as wide as it is tall.







Burgundy Lime was found in a row of Burgundy Lace, possibly a branch mutation. Foliage is similar but with lime green vein color which eventually occupies the whole leaf, giving the plant a two toned look. Fall color is outstanding yellow, orange and red.





Chitoseyama is an upright Japanese maple with deeply divided leaves. The new leaves come in a rich red that fades to a bronzed green in summer. This new red growth contrasts with older green leaves giving the plant a two-toned effect. Chitoseyama has strong stocky growth and makes an outstanding specimen with excellent red fall color. (One thousand years)





Chizome is a upright palmatum of shorter stature with light green spring foliage maturing to a glossy green. Fall color is a nice yellow and orange.





Chuguji is a green Japanese Maple, somewhat taller than wide. Spring foliage is a yellow green with red tips. Mature size will be in the 10' range. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Clarabell</u> is a new upright A. palmatum with orange yellow spring growth. Early foliage is more red than Katsura. Mature height is unknown but probably under 12'. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Crimson Carole</u> is an attractive red upright Japanese maple. The spring growth is an excellent garnet with orange overtones that transitions to an orange-red fall color. At maturity it will grow to be a medium sized tree at around 18'.





<u>Crimson Prince</u> is a red upright that is narrower than a Bloodgood. The summer color is pleasing lavender that distinguishes it from the other red uprights. The fall color is a warm red. Mature height will approach 20'.





<u>Crispine's</u> is a new lime green palmatum. It is an attractive plant that will stand out in the landscape. Fall color is a clear yellow. Winter bark is a distinctive pea green. Mature height is unknown but probably in the 12 to 15' range.







<u>Debbie's Golden Splendor</u> is a wide growing Japanese maple to 18'. Spring color is a bright orange, fading to yellow and then to chartreuse green as the summer progresses. Fall color returns to an excellent orange.





<u>Deshojo</u> is a variegated upright, spring color is a bright red, but not long lasting. Summer color is a medium green. It is more upright than Shindeshojo or Beni maiko, to about 16'. Fall color is a bright scarlet.





Dulce is an upright bushy palmatum with distinctive long pedicles and long narrow leaf tips. Spring color has apricot orange to red foliage, maturing to green. Fall color is a bright orange and red. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 14 to 16' range.





E. P. is an upright red Japanese maple grown for its ability to withstand the southern US climate. The fall color is a crimson red. E.P. will reach 18' tall at maturity.



Ed Carmine is an upright palmatum with beautiful carmine red spring growth. Summer color is a deep green. It will grow to a round headed tree to about 12'. Fall color is a bright scarlet.

Ed Wood (Woods #2) is a green Acer japonicum with very large leaves, named for plantsman Ed Wood. It tends to be shorter and rounder in stature than Fernleaf or Vitafolium. Fall color is an excellent orange and red.



Edna Bergman is a strong growing palmatum to 18 to 20'. Spring growth is a beautiful pink red, fading in the summer heat to a medium green. Fall color is an excellent orange to red.





<u>Elegans</u> is a small round topped palmatum. Spring foliage is brushed with pink, soon fading to deep green. Fall color is an excellent orange and red.





<u>Elwood Orange</u> is an attractive upright grower in the Katsura family. Spring foliage is a outstanding bright Orange red. Yellow foliage last well into the summer. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is a deep red.







Emmitt's Pumpkin is an upright Acer japonicum with beautiful orange new growth. The plant is narrow when young but will form a round head in time to about 18'. Fall color is an excellent yellow, orange and red.





Emperor 1 is the best red upright to appear in many years. It leafs out later than Bloodgood so as to avoid spring frosts. It continues to grow in adverse conditions, and is the Japanese maple of choice in Texas. Emperor 1 is shorter and wider than Bloodgood, and has strong red fall color.





Esk Sunset is a shade tree sized Acer pseudoplatanus with outstanding variegation. Leaf color is a mix of green, cream, pink and a soft gold. Fall color is yellow to gold. Mature height will be in the 30' range. A. pseudoplatanus are extremely cold hardy.

Ever Autumn is a vigorous upright with deep green leaves. The new growth is a mix of red and orange, giving the plant a multi-tonal effect. The fall color an excellent orange-red. At maturity Ever Autumn is one of the larger palmatum varieties, possibly reaching 20'.







Falls Fire is a strong growing green palmatum grown for its outstanding fall foliage. Leaves are deeply divided giving the plant an airy feel. It will be a larger palmatum to 20'. The fall color is an outstanding show of yellow, orange and red.







<u>Fascination</u> will be a round headed small tree to about 12'. Its green leaves are deeply divided with long lobes, spring color is flushed with red. Fall color is a deep red.





<u>Fernleaf</u> (Acontifolium) is an Acer japonicum with irregular oriental branching. The irregular branching gives Fernleaf a distinctive habit even when not in leaf. The leaf color itself changes from green to rust red in summer and to orange and red in the fall. It has possibly the best fall color of any Japanese maple variety.







<u>Filicifolium</u> is a twin to Fernleaf (Acontifolium). This Acer japonicum leafs out a week after Fernleaf and colors in the fall a week later. All other characteristics are identical, including the outstanding fall color.







Final Fire is an Iseli Nursery introduction in the Pacific Rim Series. It is a A. Psuedosieboldianum palmatum Cross and is hardy to zone 5. Spring color is a soft pastel tones of yellow, and pink fading to green. Fall color is orange to a deep red. Mature height is thought to be around 20', taller than wide.





<u>Fireglow</u> is a red upright that was chosen for its true red color. It is slower growing and smaller in stature than Bloodgood, and matures in to a small tree approximately 10' tall by 8' wide.





<u>First Flame</u> is an Iseli Nursery introduction in the Pacific Rim Collection. It is a A. Psuedosieboldianum palmatum cross, rated to a zone 5 cold hardiness. Spring color is red, orange and yellow. Fall color is orange and red. It is an upright tree, taller than wide.







<u>Fujiyama</u> is a small growing Japanese Maple to 12 to 14'. Leaves are a deep glossy green and hold up well in the heat. Fall color is an excellent blend of yellow and orange. (Mt. Fuji)





Garden Glory is a beautiful Acer shirasawanum by palmatum cross. New foliage is yellow and orange which matures to a bright green. It will grow to about 12' tall and about half as wide. Fall color is orange and garnet.





<u>Giant Moon</u> is an upright Acer japonicum with huge leathery leaves. Spring flush is pink, rapidly maturing to a strong green. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is an excellent orange and red.





Gloria is a semi dwarf red A. shirasawanum; leaves fading to reddish green in heat of the summer. Height and width are unknown, but probably to 8'. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Glowing Embers</u> is a small upright palmatum with fiery red new growth. Foliage soon fades to green. It is more of an upright bush than a tree. Fall color is a bright red.





A. longpes Gold Coin is a small growing maple of Chinese origin. First leaf flush is burgundy, quickly maturing to a yellow gold. It will be a smaller growing plant to 12', as wide as tall. Fall color is yellow to white. It is probably best grown in partial shade.





<u>Gold Digger</u> is a yellow coral bark maple. Spring flush is peach quickly fading to a medium green. Fall color is yellow to a bright red. It will probably be a wide vase to about 14'





<u>Green Elf</u> is an attractive semi dwarf A. shirasawanum with small green leaves. Mature height will be in the 8 foot range, taller than wide. Fall color is an excellent pallet of gold to red.







Green Flag is an Acer shirasawanum by palmatum cross. Leaves are green and show more shirasawanum characteristics than palmatum. It will grow to a small tree around 8'. Fall color is a good yellow and orange.







<u>Green Palmatum</u> is the underappreciated majestic green seedling. It is fast growing and adaptable to many climates. The form is upright when young, only to spread as it matures. The fall color is yellow to orange to red.

<u>Green Star</u> is an upright maple similar in form to Osakazuki, but with warm orange fall color rather than red. Summer leaves are thick and a glossy green. It will be a larger palmatum in excess of 20'.





<u>Green Tea</u> is an upright green palmatum with distinctive emerald colored leaves. Spring growth has a reddish pink cast. Mature height and width are unknown. Fall color is a deep red.





Hagoromo is an upright green palmatum with leaf lobes divided all to the base (Sessel form). Spring foliage has pinkish cast soon maturing to a deep green. Mature height is in the 14' range. Fall color is yellow to orange. (Feathered Clothing)



<u>Hanezu hagoromo</u> has deeply divided leaves that form 5 stalk less leaflets per leaf. Spring color is a bright orange and is very noticeable in the landscape. Mature height is unknown but probably in the 10 to 12' range. Fall color is orange and red. (Orange Feathers)







<u>Harasume</u> is an upright maple with attractive orange spring color, rapidly fading to a medium green. It will form a medium sized tree to about 14'. Fall color is an excellent red that can have yellow sand dusted variegation as the color changes. (Spring Rain)





Hefners Red is a formal red upright. It is reputed to hold its color better than any other red upright in the south, making it a must for every Southerners wish list. It is a worthwhile addition to the red upright group.





<u>Heptalobum</u> is a strong growing green upright similar in form and leaf to Osakazuki. Leaves are a deep green turning yellow, orange and red in the fall.





<u>Herbstfeuer</u> is a formal green upright Acer circinatum. The spring foliage is a pleasing yellow-green that matures to dark green. This color tinges with purple in late summer. Herbstfeuer has excellent orange-red fall color.





Higasayama is a variegated upright. Its second year wood has cream and red edges on green leaves. The Higasayama has spectacular spring buds in shape of a fiddle head. New growth is of the green palmatum leaf. It has orange and red fall foliage. Higasayama's form is semicolumnar.








<u>Hilleri</u> is a medium sized red upright of European origin with deeply divided leaves. Leaves maturing to a reddish green. Fall color is a bright crimson.





<u>Hippy fin mo</u> is an upright green vase with leaves curling upwards. It is virtually identical to Okushimo, but may be wider spreading. Fall color is yellow.





<u>Hiryu</u> is a vase shaped palmatum with cream edging on deeply divided green leaves. It is a smaller plant than Ao kanzanshi with it's leaves more distorted and twisted. Fall color is orange and red. (Flying Dragon)





<u>Hogyoku</u> is a compact formal upright palmatum with rich glossy green foliage. The fall color is an outstanding orange and red. Hogyoku makes an attractive specimen growing up to 18', and will be taller than it will be wide. (A jewel)







Hot Blonde is an A. oliverianum palmatum cross selected for heat tolerance. Spring color is a golden yellow with orange margins, holding yellow color well into the summer. Fall color is a bold red. It will be a strong grower to 20'





Hubbs Red Willow (Hobbs) is a linearlobum variety similar to Atrolineare, but more of a true red color. The leaves have distinctive sawtooth serrations. Hubbs Red Willow is a stocky plant with a full appearance when it is young.





<u>lbo nishiki</u> is a larger growing rough bark maple with bright green leaves. The fall color is a nice orange and red. It is slower to show bark roughness than Pine Bark. (Wart bark)







Ichigyoji is a similar plant to Osakazuki. The fall color in Oregon is garnet red, not the yellow and orange described in Vertrees book of Japanese Maples. Ichigyoji forms a round-headed plant approximately 16' in height.



<u>Ide no sato</u> is a medium growing A. palmatum to about 12'.Leaves are glossy green and hold up well under hot conditions. It's best feature is an excellent orange fall color.







lijima sunago is a large leaf upright with garnet red spring color. This color fades to a purple brown in summer. Its orange-red fall color is its best feature. Iijima sunago's reported sand dust fleck variegation is seldom seen. It makes for a stocky plant wider than tall, to approximately 12'.





Illini Sunrise is a cold hardy red palmatum, fading to reddish green in the summer. It is reputed to be cold hardy in Illinois. Fall color is orange and red. Height is unknown but probably in the 16 to 18' range.





Inazuma is a strong growing red upright, possibly exceeding 20' in height. Spring color is a dark purple red, fading to a purple green in heat of summer. It has excellent crimson fall color. (Thunderer)





Incognito is a green maple with deeply divided leaves. Spring growth is a distinctive orange pink maturing to a deep forest green. It will be a pyramidal shape plant to about 12 to 14'. Autumn foliage is an excellent red.







<u>Indian Summer</u> is an A. japonicum x palmatum cross selected for its cold hardiness. Mature height is unknown. Fall color expected to be orange and red.





<u>Italy Red</u> is a red upright of shorter stature. It holds its color well in heat of summer. Like Fireglow, it is used in small gardens where other uprights would get too large. Mature height is around 10'. Fall color is scarlet.







<u>Itaya</u> is a shorter stocky A. japonicum with large round leaves slightly more cut in than Vitafolium. As with all japonicums the fall display is an outstanding yellow, orange and red.







<u>Jocus pocus</u> is a member of the sesselform group with the leaves divided into five leaflets. It will be taller than wide, similar in form to beni hagoromo. New growth is orange red rather than the true red of Beni hagoromo.









<u>Japanese Sunrise</u> is similar to Sango kaku, but with peach colored winter bark, rather than the coral bark. It is a rapid grower with lime green foliage that forms a wide vase. Japanese Sunrise has possibly the best fall color of all the coral bark types.





Japonicum 6910 is a strong grower with attractive yellow-green new growth over deep green older leaves. It has an excellent orange and red fall color. It will form a larger maple possibly up to 20' tall.





<u>JE Jubilee</u> is an upright red palmatum taller than wide. This plant should not be confused with the variegated scion Jubilee. Foliage is similar to Suminagashi or Burgundy Lace but the lobes are cut almost to the base. Fall color is a deep scarlet.





<u>Ji jiao</u> is a strong growing palmatum with pinkish red bark. Mature height and width are unknown, but probably in the 16' range. So far, Ji jiao seems to be the hardiest of the coral bark group. (Chicken Leg in Chinese)





II is an upright red palmatum with deeply cut leaves. Spring color is a bright red fading to a medium green. Fall color is a good scarlet.







Jocus pocus is a member of the sesselform group with the leaves divided into five leaflets. It will be taller than wide, similar in form to beni hagoromo. New growth is orange red rather than the true red of Beni hagoromo.





Johin is a compact Acer Shirasawanum with plum purple leaves with distinctive light green veins. The fall color of Johin is a warm orange and red. It will form a small tree around 12' in height. (Elegant)





Johnnie's Pink is a somewhat delicate semi dwarf palmatum maturing at around 10'. Leaves emerge a light pink maturing to a muted red and then to green in summer. Fall color is orange and red.





Junihitoe is a slower growing green Acer shirasawanum with beautiful fissured bark. Its leaves are smaller than the species, and it has an excellent orange and red fall color. Junihitoe makes a small tree ideal for smaller gardens. It is only 10' by 6' at maturity. (A Woman's Ceremonial Dress)





<u>Kaede mitsuba</u> is palmatum with attractive twisted leaves. Spring foliage is a cream yellow edged with red. Mature form and size is unknown. Fall color is orange and red.





<u>Katsura</u> is a striking plant. Bright orange in spring, it changes to a yellow fading to yellow green in the summer. The fall color is a reddish orange. Katsura forms a round headed tree to approximately 15'. (Wig)





<u>Kawahara no midori</u> is a smaller version of Ukon. Spring foliage is a pale green, lighter in color than Ukon with a narrow white variegation along the leaf edge. Twigs are a bright green for winter interest, and autumn foliage is a pure yellow.





Keiser is a red linearlobum upright Japanese maple, similar to Atrolineare but more vigorous. It is somewhat prone to reversion, and care must be taken to cut out reverted wood. Fall color is a bright scarlet.





Kenbu is a green linearlobum, semi-dwarf in stature. Spring growth is a pinkish orange soon fading to a deep green. Fall color is a strong yellow and orange. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 12'. (Sword)





<u>Kihachijo</u> is a green upright with striking lime green new growth. Its leaves have a distinctive double serration and the bark is a clear green with white streaking. Kihachijo is grown for its fall color, which is an excellent blend of yellow, orange, and red. (Hachijo Island)

<u>Killarney</u> is a medium sized green leaf upright with soft yellow green foliage. Fall color is a great yellow and orange. It will form a flat topped canopy at about 12 feet.







<u>Kinran</u> is a red upright with leaves fading to green. It has an orange-red second growth which contrasts with the deep green of the mature leaves. Kinran is a beautiful gold with crimson overtone colors in the fall. The tree form is as wide as it is tall, about 15'. (Woven with golden strings)





<u>Kisetsu dore</u> is a dwarf Acer circinatum with bright orange and pink new growth over deep green, giving the plant a distinctive two-toned look. It will grow to a wide ball around 10'. Fall color is garnet. (What season is it?)







Kogane nishiki is a fast growing green upright. It will be one of the lager palmatum, possibly reaching 30'. It is grown primarily for its bright golden fall color. (Golden Brocade)





<u>Kogane sakae</u> is an upright green palmatum. Spring leaves are pinkish red, soon maturing to a bright green. It is notable primarily for it's yellow striations on green bark. Fall color is yellow. (Golden prosperity)





<u>Kokyo</u> originated as a seedling from the Emperor's palace in Tokyo. It will form an compact upright tree to about 15'. Fall color is a striking orange red. (Imperial palace)






Korean Gem is an excellent green palmatum with brilliant yellow to orange to red fall color. The spring leaf is a pleasing yellow-green maturing to a deep glossy green. It is a strong grower, and makes a larger palmatum upwards of 20' in height.








<u>Koyamandari nishiki</u> is a small palmatum with interesting foliage. Leaves are leathery, wider at leaf lobe tip than at center. Not much is known about this variety, but it probably will be a larger bush form. Fall color is yellow.





Koyasan is a compact growing maple with bronze red new growth fading to green. It will be semi columnar grower to about 10'. Fall color is butter yellow to red.





<u>Krazy Krinkle</u> is an upright Japanese maple taller than wide. Leaves have a distinctive twist and crinkle. Mature height probably will be in the 12 to 14' range. Fall color is a bright orange and red.





<u>Kurabuyama</u> is a vigorous green upright known for its excellent yellow, orange, and red fall color. The spring growth is flushed with red, soon changing to a deep green. Kurabuyama grows to be wider than it is tall at about 14'. (Mountain Contrast)





<u>Kurenai jishi (Beni shishi)</u> has the possibility to be a red Shishigashira. Spring color is a maroon red, fading to a purple green in summer. Mature height and form is unknown. Fall color is yellow and red.







Kyou no aki is a strong growing green palmatum with lime green new growth. It will be a large palmatum possibly to 20'. Fall color is an excellent clear yellow.





<u>Ladies</u> Choice is a small growing palmatum to about 10' Leaves are small and star shaped. Fall color is a bright orange and red.





<u>Linearlobum</u> is the classic green narrow-lobed upright maple. The foliage is a soft green that turns into a bright yellow-orange in the fall. Linearelobum spreads more than Ao shime no uchi reaching 16' tall by 25' wide at maturity.





Lovett is a shorter green Acer sieboldianum with medium sized leaves.

The twigs have a noticeable pubescence as leaf unfolds. Lovett has excellent orange and red fall color. It is narrow growing tree to 15 feet.





<u>Lozita</u> is a stubby red upright, more of a bush than a tree. The plant will grow to be wider than it is tall, about 8' by 10'. Its color is a dark red similar to Bloodgood. Fall color a nice scarlet.



<u>Lutescens</u> is a small upright palmatum known for it's outstanding yellow fall color. Spring leaves start pink, rapidly fading to a yellow green and finally to a good deep green. Mature height will be in the 12 to 14 foot range.





<u>Maiko</u> is a bushy growing palmatum to about 10', taller than wide. Leaf shape varies from leaf to leaf like a smaller version of Mama. Fall color is a strong yellow. (Dancing Girl)





Mama is a narrow-growing green palmatum with distinctive foliage. Each leaf is different from the next: some narrow lobed, some wider lobed, and some with a tattered appearance. The overall effect is delicate, but this is a hardy tree. Fall color is yellow-orange and quite bright. (Doing as one pleases)





Margaret Bee is a red upright, similar in color to Bloodgood. The branching is upright but stocky, giving the tree a clump-like form. Margaret Bee's fall color is a strong red. It will reach 15' by 15' at maturity.





Mary Eddingglow is a small growing red upright with cherry red spring foliage. Mature height is unknown. Fall color is crimson.





Masu murasaki is a large growing A. palmatum to around 25'. Spring color is a good purple red fading to a reddish green with distinctive venation. Fall color is an excellent red. (Rose purple)







<u>Matsukaze</u> is a broadly spreading palmatum to about 14'. In time, its branches will become semi-cascading. Spring color is garnet red, maturing to a deep green. Fall color is orange and red. (Wind in the pines)





<u>Matsuyoi</u> is an wide growing upright A. palmatum. Yellow green leaves hang vertically. Mature height is in the 14' range, wider than tall. Fall color is yellow and orange. (Evening Breeze)





Meigetsu is a tree form of Acer japonicum with large grapelike leaves. It has a pinkish new growth which contrasts well with its green mature foliage. Meigetsu has excellent orange and red fall colors, and will make a large stocky plant.





A. Buergerianum Michael Steinhardt is a golden trident maple. Spring flush is yellow with leaves becoming more yellow orange as summer progresses. Fall foliage is yellow to red. It will be in excess of 20' at maturity.






Microphyllum is a small leaf Acer Shirasawanum. It is upright when young, forming a smaller round tree as it matures. Fall color is a bright blend of yellow and red Microphyllum is similar to Junihitoe, but will make a larger tree to around 16'.





Mikado is a distinctive A. shirasawanum with beautiful orange red foliage that glows when back lit by the sun. Height and width are unknown but is will be a smaller tree.





Mikasayama is a rare small leaf Acer sieboldianum with fresh lime green leaves. The pubescence on spring foliage and twigs is noticeable, and it has a fantastic yellow to red fall color. Mikasayama makes a small sturdy at 15'.





Milliane's Columnar Sugar Maple is a columnar A. saccharum of very columnar form. Summer foliage is a pleasing bright green with outstanding yellow and orange fall color.

Mimaye is a green upright Japanese maple of shorter stature. The leaves curl under to form tiny umbrellas. Fall color is a pleasing orange. Mimaye will be as tall as it is wide, around 10' at maturity.





Mirte is a large growing upright palmatum. Spring leaves are a pleasing chocolate brown with distinctive green veins. Summer color is a dark olive green. Fall color is yellow and orange. Mature height may exceed 20 feet.







<u>Miyagino</u> is a wide growing green palmatum with tapering leaves. It is grown for it's excellent crimson fall foliage which can be flecked with yellow and red.





Mizu Kagiri is a small growing palmatum. Spring growth is brick red over green. Summer color becomes a deep green. It will grow to about 10 feet, wider than tall. Fall color is yellow and orange. (Passing under a waterfall)







Mizuho beni is a very similar plant to Katsura with its orange-yellow spring foliage and yellow-green foliage in the summer. It leafs out a week after Katsura and so is less likely to be damaged by spring frost. Mizuho beni will make a small tree as wide as it is tall, probably up to 12' in height.





Momenshide is an upright green palmatum with leaf lobes divided all the way to the base resembling separate leaves. This gives the plant a distinctive feathery look. It is similar to Koshimino but a fuller and better grower, to about 12'. Fall color is a yellow orange.







Mon Papa is a spreading upright maple, wider than tall. Leaves are olive green in spring maturing to a greenish red. Fall color is an outstanding orange and red.





Mon zukushi is a very old cultivar of Japanese Maple. Spring color is a pink red rapidly changing to a medium green. Mon zukushi is a vigorous growing plant to about 20'. It is grown for its excellent orange and red fall foliage. (Sacred treasure)





Monroe is an Acer circinatum with green deeply divided leaves that are reminiscent of Fernleaf. Monroe has distinctive white flowers in early spring, and the branches are stiff and upright. Its mature height is only about 12' but it is considerably wider in circumference.







Moon Shadow is a pretty green palmatum as wide as tall to about 12'. Spring foliage is orange and yellow, maturing to a bright green. Fall color is yellow and orange.





Moonfire is a red upright that is more spreading in its shape than Bloodgood. It holds a deep red all summer, deep crimson in the fall. The branches are gray, black and sinuous. Moonfire will be only 12' tall by 15' wide at maturity.





Moonrise (Minori no tsuki) is a new Acer shirasawanum introduced by Carl Munn. It is a much better grower than Aureum and has distinctive pink red spring foliage. Mature height is unknown but probably in the 12 to 14' range. Fall color is an excellent orange red. (Harvest Moon)





<u>Muri hibari</u> is a green upright A. palmatum with deeply divided serrated leaves. Spring growth is tinged with red. It will form an open wide tree to about 15'. Fall color is a bright crimson. (Flock of Skylarks)





Murogawa is spreading red upright with spring color an orange red with green venation. Summer brings a deep bronze green color. With age Murogawa becomes somewhat weeping. Fall color is yellow to crimson.



Musa kagami has pink red spring growth, fading to a chartreuse green. Second growth gives the tree a rosy overcast. It will form a round headed tree to about 12'. Fall color is a bright scarlet. (Mirrored drinking glass)







<u>Musashino</u> is a fast growing formal red upright with truly outstanding crimson fall foliage. Spring color is an red purple and holds up well in heat of summer. It is seldom grown but one of the better red uprights. It may be the same variety as Nomura nishiki.





Naruto kaede is a large growing, robust A. buergarianum to about 20' The triangular shaped leaves are cupped to form a T. Fall color is gold to red.





Newton Sentry is an extremely narrow form of Sugar Maple. While somewhat awkward when young, it makes a statuesque specimen with age. Leaves are green and slightly smaller than the species. Fall color is a bright orange.








<u>Nicholsonii</u> is a medium growing A. palmatum grown mostly for its outstanding crimson fall foliage. Spring leaves are reddish green soon maturing to an attractive medium green. Branching is horizontal and height can reach about 16'.





<u>Nigrum</u> is a dark black red upright palmatum. It is an old variety and seldom grown, but is reputed to hold it's color well in the South. Fall color is a deep maroon.







Nishiki momiji is a green upright palmatum. Its new growth is orangered and twisted. The color fades to green as the leaf matures. It has excellent orange and red fall color. Nishiki momiji forms a spreading crown, wider than it is tall at approximately 12'.





Northwind is a striking palmatum x Psuedosieboldianum cross said to withstand temperatures to -30 degrees F. Spring foliage is reddish fading to a medium green in summer. Fall color is an excellent scarlet orange. It will mature to about 15'.





Novum is a tall growing red upright with light purple red spring leaves. The summer color fades to a orange red and then to reddish green. Fall color is a bright crimson.





<u>Nuresagi</u> is a formal red upright palmatum with stiff upward branching. It holds red-purple color throughout the summer, and it has a garnet red fall color. It will grow to 18' tall but only 10' wide. (Wet heron)







Ogon sarasa has deep black red spring foliage with contrasting green veins. Summer color fades rapidly to a bronze green. It will form a small wide tree to about 15 feet. It's best feature is bright orange and red fall color. (Gold calico cloth)







Ogurayama is a medium-sized Acer sieboldianum with light yellowgreen spring foliage that changes to a medium green in the summer. It has silver pubescence on the twigs and the early spring foliage. It has excellent orange and red fall color. Ogurayama has a softer outline and foliage than Lovett.







Oisami is a spreading Acer japonicum that grows in excess of 20', as wide as tall. Leaves are cut in, but not as much as Fernleaf. Fall color is brilliant yellow orange and red.





Okagami is a large-growing red upright tree with a strong structure. It has beautiful purple-red foliage which fades to a mix of red and green in heat of summer. Okagami will make one of the larger palmatum varieties, probably over 20' tall. (Big mirror)






Okushimo is a vase-shaped green palmatum. Its leaf lobes curl upward forming a tapered tube. Okushimo retains its narrow vase shape at maturity and is suitable for small spaces. It has beautiful gold fall color. (The pepper and salt leaf)





Omato has a bright pink and red spring growth which fades to a deep green. Its fall color is a good orange and red. Omato will grow to be a large-sized maple, around 20'. (Gold calico cloth)





Omurayama is the weeping willow form of Japanese maple, but does not show its pendulous habit at a young age. It has deeply divided green leaves which mature to an excellent orange fall color. It will grow to about 15' at maturity. (Omure mountain)





Orange Dream's leaves emerge orange in the spring, and it retains a yellow color well into summer. Orange Dream leafs out after Katsura, and so it avoids late frosts. It will need some supplemental water to thrive in the landscape however. Orange Dream makes a pretty small plant at only about 10'.

Orange Fan is an upright A. japonicum with outstanding orange and red Fall color. Spring growth has an orange blush in the spring, soon fading to a medium green. Mature height is unknown, but this will be a larger japonicum, possibly up to 16 to 18'.





Orange Flame is an upright palmatum with bright orange spring growth, soon fading to green. Winter bark color is orange. Mature height is unknown, but probably approaching 20'. Fall color is red.







Osakazuki oh is a vigorous green palmatum similar to Osakazuki. Leaves are large, thick, and green with outstanding red fall foliage. Mature height is unknown, but this variety is probably not a dwarf.





Osakazuki is a large-leafed green palmatum recognized for its outstanding red fall color. The new growth is an orange-pink. It has a nice red seed set. Osakazuki is a large, big boned grower reaching up to 25' tall by 15' wide. (Big cup of sake)







Oshio beni is a red upright with leaves that are more orange than red. These fade to bronzed red in heat of summer. The fall color is a garnet red. It has excellent wide branching, forming a tree as wide as it is tall around 18'. (Red press)







Oshu shidare is a red weeping willow form of Japanese maple. Its foliage is orange-red, fading to red-green in summer. The fall color is a strong orange red. Similar to Omurayama, the plant doesn't show weeping characteristics at a young age. Oshu shidare is a small round-headed plant approximately 12' in height.





Otaki is a green Acer japonicum with divided leaves, although not as divided as Fernleaf. It has outrageous fall colors in red, gold, and orange. Otaki forms a stocky plant to 16'.







<u>Pacific Fire</u> is a green A. circinatum with bright red winter bark. It forms a small tree to around 15'. Outside the Northwest it should probably be grown in dappled shade. Fall color is yellow orange.





<u>Pacific Purple</u> is a multi stemmed form of A. circinatum introduced by JF Schmidt. It will grow to about 10', wide as tall. New growth a reddish green, maturing to a deep purple. Fall color is orange.







Pacific Sprite is a columnar form of Acer circinatum. Leaves are green and crinkled. Even at maturity Pacific Sprite remains narrow, taller than wide to about 14'. Fall color is yellow orange.





<u>Palmatifolium</u> is a larger upright growing A. shirasawanum. It has distinct foliage with eleven lobes per leaf which curl under. It is more heat tolerant than most of the A. shirasawanum. Fall color is an excellent Gold.






<u>Peve Stanley</u> is a red upright maple with beautiful star shaped, deeply cut leaves. It has an upright tree form rather than the bush form of Peve Dave. Mature height and width are unknown.





Peve Starfish is a smaller growing maple, leaf lobes curling under to give the appearance of a starfish. Spring flush is a bright red maturing to a deep maroon. Fall color is a brilliant crimson. Mature size is unknown, but suitable for a smaller garden.





Pine Bark is a green upright maple with a palmatum leaf. The bark is corky and pine-like in texture, adding winter interest to this strong growing tree. It has truly excellent rosy red to taillight red fall color. Pine Bark is a husky plant, as wide as it is tall, approximately 20'. There is a great deal of confusion on the true Japanese name of this cultivar, so Pine Bark is used as a compromise.







<u>Pixie</u> is a red upright with vigorous tight growth. It holds deep purple color throughout the summer. The fall color is red. The Pixie's structure is narrow and almost columnar when young, and remains semi-columnar even as it rounds out with age to 15'. Unlike the name implies, Pixie is not a dwarf.





<u>Purple Thunder</u> is a new red A. shirasawanum with leaf lobes curled under, similar to Trompenburg. It with be a larger grower to 20'. Fall color is a bright crimson,





Red Baron is a red upright developed by Dick Wolff—creator of Emperor 1. Its color is a purple-red that it holds through the heat of summer. The plant is upright but wide-branching. A rapid grower, Red Baron makes an excellent specimen tree. It may reach 20' at maturity.





Red Blush has beautiful orange red spring foliage with distinctive green veins. It is then rather unattractive until fall, when leaves become a bright orange and red. It will form a round headed tree to about 12'.





Red Cloud is a red linearlobum maple, similar to Atrolineare. The new growth is orange-red in color, forming a pillowy cloud wider than tall. It will form a tree 12' by 12' at maturity. Red Cloud has a pleasing red fall color.





Red Dawn is a red Acer shirasawanum/palmatum cross. It is a vigorous grower, probably as wide as it is tall to 16' feet. The fall color is an orange-red. Being a red A. shirasawanum makes this variety very desirable.





Red Flash is a upright palmatum with true red spring coloration, fading to a purple red and then green as the leaf matures. Fall color is crimson. Height and width are unknown.





Red Palmatum (Atropurpereum) is the red seedling form of Acer palmatum. The summer color is variable from purple-red to green, and the fall color is usually a clean orange-red. It is the poor man's Bloodgood.





Red Saber is a red upright with deeply cut leaves, leaves similar to an Burgundy Lace. Mature height is unknown, but it seems to be more uniform grower than Burgundy Lace. Fall color is scarlet.





Red Wonder is a small growing red upright to about 12 feet. Spring color is a garnet red maturing to purple. It seems to have good color retention. Fall color is a strong crimson.





Red Wood is a member of the coral bark group found by Ed Wood. It has the vase shape of Sango kaku. Branch color is coral red, fall color is yellow and then orange, and grows to about 16'.





Rezek is a columnar Acer platanoides (or Acer pseudoplatanoides) extremely narrow in form. It forms a single stem post to 20'. Spring and summer foliage is a deep glossy green and has yellow orange fall color. Curley Lamppost is a nearly identical sister seedling.





Rising Sun is a large growing A. japonicum with extraordinarily large leaves, sometimes to 8" across. It is a vigorous multi branched tree to 20'. Like all japonicum, is has excellent autumn foliage of yellow, orange and red.





Rite of Spring is a new A. shirasawanum cross with outstanding spring color. New growth ranges from amber to red and is quite bright.

Summer color fades to a medium green. Fall color is orange and red.

Mature height and width are unknown but probably greater than 15'.





Ruby Ridge is a red upright with curved and twisted leaves; and contrasting green veins. Spring color is a pinkish red, maturing to a dark purple. It fades to red green in summer before turning orange and garnet in fall. It will form an upright bush to about 8'.





Ruby is a red form of Acer japonicum growing to a small tree of about 12". The red leaves fade to red green in the heat of summer. It relatively rare in the trade but is a welcome addition to the A. japonicum group. Fall color is a good red.





Rugose is a different upright palmatum to about 10'. Leaves are twisted and rough in texture. Leaves are red in spring, fading to a medium green. Branches are also twisted giving the plant a distinct look. Fall color is a good orange and red. It is probably the same scion as Red Rugose.



Ruth's Red has the blackest red leaves of any of the Japanese maple varieties. It retains its dark color throughout the summer. The fall color is orange and red. Its mature size is unknown, but it is probably under 16'.





<u>Saku</u> is a small growing A. palmatum to about 12'. It has pretty red tips on the new growth maturing to a glossy green. Fall color is an excellent gold, orange and red.





<u>Samadare</u> is a wide spreading green upright with spring leaves a soft pink. Leaves mature to a deep green in summer. Fall color is an excellent blend of yellow, orange and red. (Early summer rain)





<u>Samurai Sword</u> is a red upright Japanese maple that is more purple than red. It holds its color well into the summer. The fall color is a strong crimson.





Sango kaku is the famous coral bark maple. The leaves are a bright lime green with excellent yellow through red fall color. Sango kaku is more vase-shaped than Beni kawa. It is a tree for all four seasons of the year. (Coral Tower)







<u>Sanguneum</u> is an large growing palmatum with blood red spring growth, fading to an orange red. It will mature to a wide tree at about 20'. Fall color is orange and red.










Saoshika is a wide growing bushy tree to about 10'. Spring growth is a yellow green tipped with red, fading to a soft green. Leaves are not as glossy or as dark green as Saotome or Shigarami. Fall color are yellow, orange and red.





<u>Saotome</u> is a small growing Japanese maple to about 10'. Small leaves tipped with rusty red in springtime. Fall color is an excellent gold, orange and red. (Rice planting Girl)





<u>Satsuki beni</u> is an upright palmatum with lime green leaves, growing to 16 to 18' tall. Its bright color allows it to stand out in the landscape. Fall color is an excellent orange and red.





<u>Sazanami</u> is a wide-growing green palmatum with flowing branches, giving image to its name: the tidal wave. The new growth is red-orange, and it has an excellent deep red fall color. (Ripple or wave)







Scarlet Wonder is a red upright with scarlet red new growth, fading to a deep purple red. The tree holds red color well in heat. It will be a medium sized tree 14 to 16' at maturity, taller than wide. Fall color is an very good scarlet.





Scolopendrifolum Rubrum is one of a cluster of plants with similar red linearlobum leaves. It is probably a parent of or a seedling of Atrolineare. It is somewhat more upright than Atrolineare but other characteristics are the same.






<u>Scolopendrifolum</u> is an upright green maple with long, narrow bright green leaves that give the plant a bamboo like appearance. The spring color has a distinctive pink tone; the fall color is an excellent red. Scolopendrifolium makes a medium-sized Japanese maple, taller than it is wide.





<u>Seiryu</u> is an upright green laceleaf. The foliage is a pleasant bright green that gives the plant a delicate appearance. Seiryu is a strong grower with excellent orange and red fall foliage. (Pure stream)







<u>Sekka yatsubusa</u> is an upright green palmatum with spatulate twigs. Specimens have a distinctive layered look. Sekka yatsubusa's fall color is a good orange and red. It makes for a large tree up to 20' in height.








<u>Sensu</u> is a broad Acer shirasawanum by palmatum cross with green serrated leaves. It shows more palmatum than Shirasawanum characteristics. The fall color of Sensu is an excellent orange and red. (Moving fan)





Shadow Selection is an upright with bright pink flush maturing to a strong green. The plant is vigorous and has beautiful orange and yellow fall foliage. Mature height is unknown but this will be a larger palmatum.







<u>Sharon</u> is a small red upright with pink red spring color, leaves maturing to a deep purple red. Mature height is unknown, but probably under 12 feet. Fall color is garnet red.





Sherwood Flame is a red upright, and it is the seedling of, and similar to, Burgundy Lace. Sherwood Flame forms a smaller and more uniform tree. It holds its color well in the heat of summer and has pleasing red fall color.







Shigarami is a green palmatum with star shaped leaves. The spring foliage is a bright green with tips dipped in red-purple. The fall color is a rich yellow-orange. It is similar to Tsuma gaki, but is much easier to grow. The horizontal branching of Shigarami makes a pleasingly layered specimen, taller than it is wide. (Post in a river to which boats are tied)



<u>Shigure zono (Shigure zome)</u> is a small growing palmatum to about 12 feet. Spring color is purple red fading to a reddish green. Fall color is yellow to red.





<u>Shikage ori nishiki</u> is an old Japanese variety, seldom grown. New foliage is purple red soon fading to a dull green. It will grow as a wide tree to about 14 feet. Fall color is yellow and orange.








Shinju is an upright green palmatum with large leaves. Fall color is a good orange to red. Bright green bark gives the plant additional winter interest. Best guess, the plant will in the twenty foot range at maturity. (Pearl)





Shinobuga oka is a similar plant to Linearlobum or Ao shime no uchi but more upright in form. Leaves are green, linearlobum with wider lobes on the immature foliage. The plant described here is not the same plant as Scolopendrifolum.





<u>Shira Red</u> is a red Acer shirasawanum by palmatum cross. It is a spreading upright that will probably reach 10'. Spring color is a bright red, fading to a green red in the summer. Fall color is a garnet orange.





Shiro is an upright vase shaped palmatum to about 10'. Small green leaves turn whitish in summer. (White)







Shishigashira forms an upright, sculptured vase with curled green leaves. The compact growth makes the plant ideal for small gardens or for bonsai. The fall color is orange and red. (Lion's head or mythical lion)







Shojo nomura is a formal red upright that is taller than it is wide. The leaves fade to garnet/orange-red with green over tones in the summer. Shojo nomura is similar to Nuresagi, but is broader at maturity. (Red faced monkey)





<u>Shoryu no tsume</u> is a fine strapleaf Acer sieboldium. Foliage is a deep green with noticeable pubescence on bright red twigs. Mature height is unknown, but probably less than 12'. Fall color is an excellent red. (Claw of the Dragon)





<u>Skeeter's Broom</u> is a red witches' broom from Bloodgood, that grows columnar in habit. It is narrower in its growth than Twombly's Red Sentential. Skeeter's Broom will probably grow 12' in height by 6' diameter in 20 years. The spring color is a distinctive pink-red.





Streetwise is a spreading green A. buergerianum. It is a good tree where the plant needs to stay under the powerlines. The bark peels to a pleasing orange gray and brown. Fall color is a deep burgundy.





Suminagashi is a red upright with leaves similar to Burgundy Lace. It is more upright however and has greener bark. Its most outstanding feature is its bright red seed set that hang like ornaments on a Christmas tree. Its red foliage fades in the summer heat but returns with outstanding taillight red for its fall color. Suminagashi is a vigorous grower to 20' in height. (Black ink throw)





<u>Summer Gold</u> is a nice yellow palmatum that retains it's color through out the summer. Spring growth is a bright orange. It will mature to a medium sized upright, perhaps to 15'. Fall color is a robust yellow gold and orange.





<u>Summer Sunset</u> is a large growing red upright which holds its color well in the South. Leaves are large, red in the spring, maturing to purple red in summer.





Superbum is also known as Attraction. It is a fast growing larger maple to 20' as wide as tall. Spring brings deep purple leaves, which fade to a reddish green in heat of summer.





<u>Swat Margaret</u> is an old red upright variety of larger stature. It is an uncommon variety with red foliage that holds its color well in the summer and has bright crimson fall color.





<u>Syuka</u> is a bright green vigorous upright palmatum with pinkish new growth. The plant is primarily grown for its outstanding red and gold autumn foliage. Mature height is unknown, but probably in the 16 to 18' range.





<u>Takao</u> is an upright green palmatum, bushy in habit, that holds it's leaves in clusters. It is reminiscent of a tree form of Ryuzu. Fall color is an excellent gold and orange.





<u>Taki no gawa</u> is a semi dwarf A. japonicum forming shrub to about 10', as wide as tall. It gives the appearance of a small version of Vitafolium. Fall color is an excellent orange and red.





<u>Tana</u> is a green upright with yellow-green foliage. Its leaves are tipped with a distinctive purple-red color, maturing to a solid green. The fall color is a bright gold and red. The leaves of Tana are similar, but more deeply divided and smaller than Shigarami.









<u>Tanabata</u> is a upright palmatum, red in the spring fading to a reddish green in summer. Foliage is saw toothed and almost divided to the leaf base. It's mature height will in the 16' range, becoming spreading with age. Fall color is red. (Festival of the Stars)








<u>Tancho</u> is a smaller sized A. buergerianum similar to Naruto. Leaves form a sharp t-shape with leaf lobes curled upward.. Fall color is strong yellow maturing to orange. It will form a dense bush to about 10'.







Tatsuta is a small growing palmatum to about 10', of very old origin.


New growth often tipped in red fading to green. It is grown primarily for it's outstanding scarlet and crimson fall color. (From the Tatsuta River)






<u>Tennyo no hoshi</u> is a formal green upright with cream variegation of the leaf margins. It is a similar tree to Ao kanzanshi, but with perhaps less variegation and more twisted leaves. Fall color is pink and red. (Angel of the stars)






<u>Tharandt</u> is a Acer platanoides of German origin with glossy almost round leaves. Some leaves have small lobes. It will grow to a large tree to around 50° , as wide as tall. Fall foliage is unknown.





<u>The Bishop</u> is a large growing red upright. Spring color is a purple red fading to a reddish green. By far it's best characteristic is the outstanding crimson fall color.





<u>Tobiosho</u> is a selected green palmatum, grafted for its outstanding fall color. The fall color is an excellent blend of orange and red. It matures to an upright wide tree around 20' in height. Tobiosho performs well in hot and dry climates.





<u>Toshi</u> is a formal growing A. palmatum to about 14', taller than wide. Spring color is a purple red which fades to a reddish green. Fall color is a deep red.







Trompenburg is a vigorous growing red upright. The leaf lobes roll under distinctively, and have a glossy, deep red color. The fall color is scarlet. Trompenburg layers out to make a large, outstanding specimen, 20+' at maturity.





<u>Tsuchigumo</u> is a semi-dwarf tree with small green crinkled leaves. New growth is a rosy red that transitions to a bright green. The fall color is a bright gold and red. Tsuchigumo is only about 10' at maturity, making it ideal for patio use. (The ground spider)







<u>Tsukasa silhouette</u> is a columnar form of palmatum. At maturity it will be similar in size and shape to Twomblys Red Sentential but green. Fall color is an excellent orange and red.





<u>Tsukebane</u> is a fast growing upright palmatum. Spring foliage is a purple red, soon changing to green with a blush of red. Fall color is a good orange and red. (Ridge of Mount Tsukuba)





<u>Tsukushigata</u> is a black-red upright that fades to olive green. It has beautiful red seed set and bright orange fall color. It is wider than tall, about 12' high at maturity. (A bay on the island of Kyushu)





<u>Tsuma beni</u> is a stronger grower, and more hardy than Tsuma gaki. It has glossy green leaves with outstanding red leaf tips in the spring. The fall color is a great orange-red. It will probably reach 10' by 10' at maturity.





<u>Tsuri nishiki</u> has a deeply divided green leaf. The leaves are often twisted, and have a distinctive red monkey face venation on the new growth. The fall color is orange and red. It will mature to a plant wider than tall, to about 12'. Tsuri nishiki is similar to Nishiki momiji.





Twombly's Red Sentential is a red upright witches' broom with compact columnar growth. It is not as columnar as Pixie or Skeeters Broom, but it is an attractive fast-growing tree. It has red fall color and tremendous commercial appeal.





<u>Ueno homare</u> is a member of the Katsura group with bright orange spring growth fading to a mid green. It is possibly the same variety as Ueno yama. Fall color is a good orange and red.

<u>Ueno yama</u> is brighter orange-yellow in the spring than Katsura. The fall color is a bright orange. Ueno yama leafs out after Katsura, thus avoiding some spring frosts, and it is more upright in its structure. It is probably the same tree as Ueno homare.





<u>Ukon</u> is an upright with bright yellow-green growth. The bark is a bright green and very conspicuous in the winter. The fall leaf color is a clear strong yellow. Ukon is a similar plant to Aoyagi, but is a stronger grower.







<u>Umagae</u> is a medium growing palmatum to about 20'. Spring color is a brick red maturing to a purple black. It has a good show of lime green seed that contrast against the dark foliage. Fall color is a bright orange, finishing with crimson. (Plum Branch)








<u>Utsu semi</u> is a sturdy green upright. Spring foliage is a soft green maturing to a deep green. Thick glossy leaves give the plant heat and wind tolerance. Fall color is a bright scarlet. (Grasshopper skin)



<u>Vandermoss Red (Christie Ann)</u> is red upright with deeply divided leaves. It is a vigorous grower, upright when young, rounding as it matures to about 18'. Fall color is red.





Ven's Broom is a vase shaped grower to 10 to 12' It is a fast grower for a broom with no brooming apparent. It has small green leaves and yellow to orange fall foliage.





<u>Vitafolium</u> is a vigorous growing green Acer japonicum with grape leaflike leaves. The branching habit is more uniform than Fernleaf, and it makes for a strong, stocky tree around 20' in height. Vitafolium has magnificent orange and red fall colors.





<u>Voluble</u> has a bright yellow green spring growth, fading to a medium green. It is a tall narrow grower to around 16'. Fall color is a bright mix of yellow to crimson.

<u>Waka midori</u> is a small growing palmatum with yellow green foliage maturing to a light green. Fall color is a warm red. (Young Green)





Wakehurst Pink is a wide growing palmatum to about 12 feet. Spring growth is pink fading to pink over green and then to a medium green. Fall color is a pinkish red.

<u>Wattez</u> is a small growing palmatum, wider than tall. Spring foliage is a brick red. Fall color is a mix of yellow, orange and red.





<u>Werners Pagoda</u> is an upright green palmatum that layers out to form a distinctive triangular (or pagoda) shaped plant. The fall color is yellow, orange, and red. It makes an excellent specimen.

<u>Wetumpka Red</u> is a compact red palmatum. It is best suited for an area where a smaller red upright is needed. It will reach 10 to 12' at maturity. Fall color is scarlet red.





Whitney Red is an red upright with deep purple foliage. Habit is similar to Bloodgood, but the leaf lobes are more deeply divided. Fall color is a striking red. Mature height is in the 18' range.







<u>Winter Gold</u> is slower growing form of palmatum with yellow twigs in the winter. Mature height is unknown, but best guess is 12 to 14' as wide as tall. Fall color is a good clear yellow.



<u>Winter Orange</u> is a new coral bark type with orange winter bark rather than coral red. Mature height and width are unknown but appear to be similar to Sango Kaku. Spring growth has a red blush soon maturing to a chartreuse green. Fall color is a bright yellow and orange.





<u>Winter's Columnar Red</u> is a red columnar upright closely resembling Skeeter's Broom. Fall color is a bright red. Mature height is unknown.





<u>Wou nishiki</u> is an upright green palmatum with deeply divided leaves. The new foliage has bright rose margins. The fall color is an outstanding orange and red. Wou nishiki forms a round-headed tree approximately 16' tall.

Yama kagi is a Don Schmidt Nursery, Inc. selection of Acer japonicum. This japonicum has large grape-like leaves, which unlike other japonicums, are less likely to burn or turn leathery in the heat of summer. The fall color is an outstanding yellow, orange and red. It is an upright grower that is as wide as it is tall to 20' (Mountain shadows)



<u>Yama kuzure</u> is a vigorous green palmatum. New growth is a bright lime green. Branching is robust and it will form a tree as wide as tall. Fall color is a brilliant orange. (Irregular mountain)







<u>Yasmin</u> is an upright Acer shirasawanum x palmatum cross. Leaves are a deep red, fading to red green. It is a vigorous grower, almost columnar when young to over 20'. Fall color is garnet orange to red.





Yellowbird is a green upright similar in shape to Osakazuki, but with leaves that are more deeply incised. The spring foliage is a peach-orange that fades to a lime green. Yellowbird is grown for its excellent yellow fall color, and it makes a lovely yellow counter point to Osakazuki in the landscape.





<u>Yellow Threads</u> is a wide spreading linearlobum maple with a broad canopy. Narrow leaves are yellow green in spring, maturing to yellow in summer. Fall color is a strong yellow to orange. Mature size is unknown.

<u>Yezo nishiki</u> is a red upright with purple-red leaves. Yezo nishiki is upright in form while young, and is a similar plant to Shojo nomura or Nuresagi. Fall color is scarlet red.





<u>Yubae</u> is a red upright Japanese maple with translucent leaves. Variegation is seldom (or never) seen. It is however one of the better red uprights in color especially with the light shining through leaves. The fall color is a crimson red. (Evening glow)





<u>Yugure</u> is an old Japanese maple cultivar with crimson spring foliage fading to a rusty green. Fall color is red. It grows as a broad upright to about 15 feet. (Twilight)
